Domain Registration Schedule
(Schedule 6)

1.0 Definitions

In this Schedule, unless the context requires otherwise, the definitions contained within the Terms and Conditions shall apply.

“**Domain Name**” means the name selected by the Customer to be registered as part of this Agreement.

“**Email Re-Direct Service**” means requesting that all email sent to the Domain Name is automatically forwarded to another address at a separate domain

2.0 Domain Registration Services

- 2.1 If webspace is required then additional charges will apply to purchase Hosting Services from the Supplier.
- 2.2 The Term or default period of registration (of the domain name) is, in default of a different period being agreed, two years.
- 2.3 In the event of a transfer of a registered domain name the Supplier will, unless advised otherwise, keep the registration name and details as currently stored.
- 2.4 Unless otherwise specified, email inbox services will not be maintained by the Supplier.

3.0 Domain Watch:

A Service can be provided whereby the “watch” can monitor a specified Domain Name with a view to attempting to register the domain in the event that the current registration expires. This Service can be purchased (at a set fee to be agreed) for the shorter of one year or the period until the domain is registered in the Customer’s name. This Service does not guarantee the domain name can be purchased, only that an attempt will be made to purchase should it become available. Should the domain be successfully purchased the Customer is liable for the domain registration fees as published by the Supplier at that date.

4.0 Registrations

- 4.1 While the Supplier will make every reasonable effort to secure and register the names requested by the Customer it cannot guarantee success of registration or that these have been secured by any third party or otherwise unavailable to the Customer.
- 4.2 Unless specified otherwise; The Customer will be responsible for monitoring the domain renewal date and one month prior to the renewal date advise the Supplier: The Supplier may notify the Customer of the renewal date in advance, but it is the Customer’s responsibility to ensure that it is aware of this date and to inform the Supplier as noted above.
- 4.3 No refunds are available once the domain has been registered; more work will entail further costs.
- 4.4 Customers will be subject to the Terms and Conditions or any applicable conditions of the domain name registration agent.
- 4.5 When the Supplier arranges or carries out a transfer of a registered domain a cost is involved.
- 4.6 If third parties cause delays, costs or other losses in connection with a transfer of a registered domain – (1/2 hour is allowed/provided for) additional time is chargeable to the Customer.
- 5.0 Customers must specify any email account and email re-direction Services required. By default none of this work is included within domain registration costs
